(February 2017 to present)

*Responsibilities:* Develop, implement and evaluate programs to ensure quality of mental health services within the jail setting. Provide clinical oversight of on-site mental health services. Create and provide ongoing training programs for mental health and medical staff as well as correctional professionals. Build and enact specialized programming for specific offender populations. Attend and engage in corporate meetings and committees relevant to mental health when requested. Assess inmates on daily basis who are currently on suicide watch precaution. Assess all inmates housed in a lockdown block on a weekly basis. Complete assessments on all patients with mental illness.

*Responsibilities:* Function as part of a multidisciplinary team while providing direct clinical and consultation services to inmates placed with Duval Regional Juvenile Detention Center. Conduct clinical assessments related to treatment for youth within a Secure Detention Center. Engage in crisis intervention and suicidal/homicidal risk assessments. Facilitate psychoeducational treatment groups and individual therapy sessions. Collaborate with prescribing psychiatrist on youth's mental health status.

**Licensed Clinical Social Worker** – Industry Residential Center,. Rush, NY

*Responsibilities:* Provide mental health treatment for male adjudicated juveniles including assessments to provide diagnoses and recommendation of placement within the facility. Completion of treatment plans, crisis intervention and suicidal/homicidal risk assessments. Provide staff consultation and staff training regarding relevant mental health diagnoses, symptoms and treatment. Provide Dialectical Behavioral Therapy and Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, including skills group training and individual therapy.

*Responsibilities:* Provide comprehensive therapeutic services to children who have been, or suspected to have been, sexually abused. Support child victims through various phases of the judicial process. Engage youth and families in Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy through individual and family therapy sessions. Provide ongoing psychoeducation on trauma and sexually reactive behaviors to youth and families. Complete Forensic Interviews with youth who have disclosed sexual abuse.

*Responsibilities:* Conduct assessments and diagnose psychiatric illness for adults and youth. Provide mental health treatment to diverse populations with mental health and substance abuse issues through individual, group and family therapy. Engage and collaborate with probation officers to ensure client adherence to mandated treatment services. Provide therapeutic crisis interventions to clients experiencing trauma including suicidal ideation, suicide attempts, homicidal ideation, acute and chronic crises.

*Responsibilities:* Conduct thorough assessments of individuals experiencing acute psychiatric crises. Collaborate with multidisciplinary team members including psychiatrists, physicians and nurses to identify patients who required admission for psychiatric inpatient treatment. Coordinate admission and discharge plans for patients upon determination of appropriate level of care to ensure safety.
